

Quality Assurance Unit Activities 2025-2026

The activities of the Quality Assurance Unit at the Faculty of Nursing include a set of practical procedures and actions carried out to fulfill the Unit's role and strategic objectives in developing and improving academic and administrative performance. The most prominent of these activities are as follows:

1. Promoting a Culture of Quality

The Unit works to strengthen the concept of quality and quality assurance within the Faculty by organizing workshops and awareness seminars, and by preparing informational bulletins and publications that highlight the importance of quality and its role in improving institutional performance. These activities target all groups within the Faculty, including faculty members, teaching assistants, administrative staff, and students.

2. Assessing Stakeholder Feedback

The Unit conducts periodic surveys and interviews to collect and assess feedback from students, faculty members, administrative staff, and leadership regarding various aspects of the educational and administrative processes. The results are analyzed and utilized to enhance institutional performance and academic programs.

3. Reviewing Academic Programs and Curricula

The Unit evaluates and reviews academic programs and curricula to ensure their alignment with national and international academic reference standards, and to ensure that intended learning outcomes are aligned with labor market needs.

4. Monitoring Plan Implementation

The Unit monitors progress in implementing annual quality plans, assesses progress toward the achievement of established objectives, identifies strengths and opportunities for improvement, and takes the necessary corrective actions.

5. Preparing Periodic Self-Evaluation Reports

The Unit prepares semi-annual and annual self-evaluation reports that include a comprehensive analysis of the level of implementation of quality standards within the Faculty, and highlight progress made in implementing improvement plans and corrective actions aimed at developing academic and administrative performance.

6. Developing and Implementing Improvement Plans

Based on the results of periodic evaluations and analyses, the Unit prepares detailed improvement plans aimed at enhancing institutional and program performance and follows up on their implementation in cooperation with all relevant departments and units.
