



## Laboratory Entry Protocol

- All laboratory users, including laboratory specialists, practical trainers, and students, must wear laboratory uniform and show their identification card before entering the laboratory.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the laboratory.
- Mobile phones must be turned off while in the laboratory.
- Tools and equipment must be used with care and caution.
- No activity is permitted inside the labs other than training and nursing activities, or without the supervision of lab instructors/lab specialists.
- All tools and models must be returned to their original places, and chairs must be replaced before leaving the lab.
- Everyone must pick up any waste from the floor and place it in the trash.
- Taking tools and equipment without permission is prohibited.
- Media, such as magnetic discs or videotapes, must be returned to their original locations or to the appropriate personnel.
- Needles and syringes must be disposed of in the sharps disposal container.
- Any spilled liquids on the floor must be wiped up.
- Each student must inform the lab specialist/lab instructor of any allergic reaction to Betadine or rubber gloves.
- Any accident or malfunction must be reported to the lab supervisor.
- No bags or clothing should be brought into the lab, and no personal references should be marked with the student's name.
- Food and beverages are prohibited inside the lab, but are permitted during break times outside the lab.
